

Rules for successful completion of a "Histology I" for students of the study program General Medicine, winter semester 2023/2024

- active participation at practical exercises
 - maximum one excused absence
 - in case of two absences, one will have to prepare a seminar paper on the topic he or she missed and present it to his or her classmates (.ppt/.pptx, about 15 minutes)
 - in case of more than two absences, the subject cannot be completed successfully (except for special cases that deserve special consideration - restrictive)
 - The level of knowledge of previously completed topics can (and will) be checked at any time during the practical exercises (orally and in writing).
 - a proactive approach to the practical exercises - getting acquainted with the current topic, voluntarily presenting one's knowledge, raising discrepancies, answering questions, ...
 - the unpreparedness/ non-cooperation during the practical exercise will be considered as an absence
- attendance of lectures in histology is strongly recommended
 - lectures are an integral part of the teaching process, practical exercises are closely related to them
 - knowledge presented in the lectures will be required in both partial and final credit tests
- presentation of the assigned topic in a practical exercise in a form of PowerPoint presentation
- participation in a small control tests at the beginning of each practical training course
- Own notebook (analog or digital) with a detailed drawing or photo of each slide, with description of each structure, in color - after each practical exercise
 - If not carried out in the desired quality during the practical exercise, the whole session will be considered as an absence
 - checked on the last practical training
- to pass three partial credit tests. To be successful, the student needs to master these three partial credit tests at least at 210% (or that is, to get an average of 70%).

Evaluation of student at the end of the semester consists of:

- the weighted average of the results of partial and final credit test (when needed) adjusted by
 - +/- 5% depending on activity during the semester
 - +/- 5% depending on quality of drawings
 - + 5% for the first 10 best rated students according to the results of small control tests

This evaluation is reviewed during final exam and has influence on the final mark.

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
