The basics of CPR in adulthood and childhood. Whole-body and partial immobilization, the procedure for multiple trauma, anaphylaxis, hypertension, psychiatric patients, primary and secondary investigation. Manage to use the ambulance equipments.										
Brief content of the course (syllabus):										
Approach to critical patient, primary and secondary examination, patient history and red flags signs. Ambulance Equipments. Life threatening conditions treatment. Wounds, fractures, burns, bleeding from wounds and body openings. Acute respiratory, cardiovascular, neurological diseases. Acute psychosis, neurosis. Basic treatment of acute pain. Polytrauma management. Mass disasters and triage. Drugs, chemicals and addictive drugs, intoxication. Use of simulated situations in accordance with the most common diagnoses.
