MICROBIOLOGY - GM students

Microbiology 1

- 1. Lecture participation is obligatory
- 2. Laboratory practical participation is obligatory
 - each student must be theoretically prepared for the actual exercise
 - each student may be excluded from laboratory practical by the staff if not prepared theoretically
 - one absence is allowed with official excuse from the physician, the excuse must be delivered at the next laboratory practical
 - in case of signs of a respiratory infection, the student will inform by e-mail in advance, no later than on the day of the practical exercise to the relevant teacher, who will make an entry in the attendance list
 - the student will compensate for that practical by preparing seminar work on a given topic (5 pages of handwritten text)
 - from each laboratory practical, the student is obliged to draw up a protocol (even in case of absence from the laboratory practical). The protocol must be sent in electronic form for approval to the relevant teacher within one week (to the next lab. practical). A maximum of 3 corrections of one protocol is allowed. If the student does not submit the correctly prepared protocol on time and the protocol is not accepted by the teacher, in this case the student must prepare a seminar work on the given topic in the range of 5 pages handwritten text and hand over the work directly to the head of the Institute of Microbiology within 5 days.
 - during the semester, there will be at least two multiple choice tests, each test must be written with a of minimum 70 % to pass
- 3. Ongoing evaluation
 - the final test for the practical exercises with a minimum of 70 %
 - in case of non-compliance with any of the mentioned conditions, the student will not be given ongoing evaluation
 - an ongoing evaluation is held in the summer semester of that specific academic year

- oral exam
- final exam is allowed only in the winter semester of that specific academic year
