Requirements for completion of the course: State exam which consist of practical and oral examination by commission of specialists. The exam is classified by grades: A, B, C, D, E, Fx grade. Minimal grade to be successful is E.					
Learning results: After attending the course, student acquires basic knowledge of anatomy and physiology of female genital tract, examination methods in gynaecology and obstetrics, fertilization and stages of embryonic development, diagnostics of pregnancy, normal pregnancy and prenatal care, normal labour and delivery, diseases in pregnancy, the assessment of foetal well-being and risks during pregnancy and labour, the immunological disorders in pregnancy, multiple pregnancies, haematologic and <i>haemorrhagic</i> complications in pregnancy, management of preterm labour and postdate pregnancy, methods of birth induction and abortion, <i>malpresentations</i> of foetus and management of abnormal labour mechanism, basic obstetrical surgery- forceps, vacuum extraction, caesarean section. Student is familiar with ethical and legal problems in obstetrics. Student has basic knowledge of the menstrual cycle and disorders of menstrual function, methods of family planning and contraception, basic information about <i>etiology</i> , clinical symptoms, diagnosing and treatment of pelvic infections and sexually transmitted diseases, benign and malignant diseases of the female genital tract, breast diseases, urinary incontinence and pelvic floor disorders. Student has basic knowledge of <i>pediatric</i> and adolescent gynaecology, climacteric and postmenopausal age, basic knowledge of management of infertility, principles of screening and prophylaxis, early diagnostics and differential diagnostics of gynaecological emergencies. Student is able to use his knowledge in gynaecological and obstetrical examination, he/she is able to diagnose the basic pathologies in gynaecological patient and in pregnancy and to suggest algorithm of diagnostic and therapeutic methods. Student takes active part in clinical diagnostic and therapeutic process, assists in operating theatre and delivery room.					
Brief content of the course: State examination – practical examination (documentation of a patient) and theoretical examination Practical part - complete examination of patient and work with the documentation (to take the anamnesis, objective examination, differential diagnostics, to suggest all kinds of examination and therapy).s Theoretical part: takes part at the specialised clinic in front of the committee of specialists. The student is asked to pick up three questions from different fields of gynaecology and obstetrics. The student answers all questions and afterwards he gets a grade given by the committee. The final grade is given by the head of the committee.
