MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

hereinafter referred to as the “Parties”,

intend to develop an academic exchange and cooperation programme in education and research and have agreed to the following:

1. Based on the principles of mutual benefit and respect for each other’s independence, the two institutions will foster:
 - a) student, academic and administrative staff exchanges;
 - b) joint research activities;
 - c) joint activities in the field of technology transfer;
 - d) exchanges of academic materials.
2. This Agreement is non-binding and is concluded solely for the purpose of establishing a basis for academic exchange and cooperation programme in education and research. Prior to initiating any specific activity or programme, the parties will negotiate and enter into a separate agreement, signed by each party's authorized signatory, describing the terms of the agreement, including the budgets.
3. It is implicit that every activity undertaken under this agreement is approved by the appropriate officials at each institution and must fall within each institution’s academic and fiscal constraints.
4. UJEP is committed to equal access to programs, facilities, admission and employment for all persons, including without limitation, equal access to programs, facilities, admission, and employment without regard to personal characteristics not related to ability, performance, or



qualifications as more fully set forth in applicable UJEP policies. Subject to applicable law, the Parties shall abide by the foregoing principles of nondiscrimination and equal access in the administration of all programs and agreements described in this Agreement, and neither Party shall impose criteria on any scholars, faculty, students or staff which would violate these principles of nondiscrimination. Nothing herein shall be deemed to create any obligation for either Party to violate any applicable law, statute, code or guideline in order to provide such access.

5. This MoU is only intended to address research and academic cooperation and does not, nor shall it be construed to, cover the generation of intellectual property. Any intellectual property created is subject to applicable legal provisions or separate agreements.
6. Neither Party may use the name, logo, or mark of the other in any promotional or advertising material (including but not limited to public announcements and program brochures) without the prior written consent of the other Party pursuant to each Party's policies.
7. This MoU shall be effective on and after the date of its signing by the authorized representatives of the two institutions, and shall remain in force for a period of five years. This MoU will automatically renew for successive periods equal to the Initial Term, unless either Party gives the other at least thirty (30) days' written notice of termination before the expiry of the Initial Term. Unaffected by an extraordinary termination for important reasons either Party shall be entitled at any time at its absolute discretion to terminate this MoU by giving at least six (6) months prior written notice to the other Party. Ongoing projects shall not be affected by a termination of the agreement.
8. This MoU may be modified at any time after due consultation between the two institutions. Changes and amendments to this MoU shall be carried out only in a written form of numbered supplements approved by both institutions.
9. This MoU is made in two copies in English each having the validity of the original. Each party will obtain one copy.
