<b>Requirements for passing the course:</b>										
The criterion for successful completion of the course is 80% participation in seminars. The evaluation of the course consists of continuous evaluation: 2 written tests (total 60 points, required level 70%, minimum 42 points) and a practical demonstration of three nursing performances. The final evaluation of the course is a summary of the results of continuous evaluation and demonstration of nursing performances. The condition for awarding credits is 70% success. The student's workload is 47 hours, it includes preparing the student for seminars in laboratory conditions.										
<b>Learning outcomes:</b>										
After completing the course, the student is able to define and explain nursing activities in preventive, diagnostic and therapeutic methods and procedures. Student independently demonstrates skills in the implementation of basic nursing procedures: measurement of vital functions of the patient, injection technique, collection of biological material, infusion, transfusion, wound dressings, catheterization, ECG. Student presents a positive approach to the patient, recognizes and accepts patient needs.

Vital signs. Wound dressing, bandaging techniques. Injection techniques. Enteral nutrition. Infusion, parenteral nutrition. Transfusion. Collection of biological material. EKG. Oxygen therapy. Catheterisation, enema.
