

Rules for Obtaining Credit fro "Histology 2" for Students of the Study Program General Medicine, Winter Semester 2024/2025

- active participation at practical exercises
 - maximum one excused absence
 - if two absences, one must prepare a seminary work regarding missed topic and present it to the classmates (.ppt/ .pptx , for about 15 minutes)
 - if three or more absences, the subject cannot be successfully completed (except of special cases deserving special consideration - restrictively)
 - level of knowledge from already absolved topics can be (and will be) checked anytime during course of practical exercises (orally and in writing)
 - a proactive approach to practical exercises - at least in outline to be acquainted with the current topic, voluntarily present one's knowledge, ask discrepancies, answer questions, ...
 - the unpreparedness/ non-cooperation in class will be classified as absence
- active work with MS Teams
 - study of online materials
 - use of online consultations
 - in the event of an unfavorable epidemiological situation, readiness to switch to distance learning
- strongly recommended participation on the lectures from histology
 - the lectures are an integral part of teaching process, practical exercises are bind to them closely
 - the knowledge presented in lectures will be required on both partial and the final credit tests
- to have own notebook with a detailed drawings of each slide, with description of each structure, in color – after each practical training
 - if not performed in desired quality during practical training, class will be classified as an absence
 - controlled on the last practical training
- During this semester, one needs to pass three partial credit tests consisting from test and of evaluating of two to three unknown specimens. For being successful, student needs to master these three partial credit tests at least at 210% (or that is, to get average of 70% in each test).

Evaluation of student at the end of the semester consists of:

- the weighted average of the results of partial and final credit test (when needed) adjusted by
 - +/- 5% depending on activity during the semester
 - +/- 5% depending on quality of drawings

This evaluation is reviewed during final exam and has influence on the final mark.

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
